As **Knots Landing's** Abby Ewing, Donna Mills has made drastic hairstyle changes through the years—from long wavy locks to the short tousled she-bob. This year the CBS nighttime drama's producers have decided Abby's character calls for longer, more sensuous hair. Just as the she-bob started its own trend, this new style is part of the current move toward long, feminine hair fashions.

Donna plans on growing her hair a little past the shoulders. She predicts hair fashions will be longer and simpler in '87 and '88, "maybe wavy, but not curly. I think the messy look is going to be out."

The blond superstar describes her hair as naturally "stick straight" and "dishwater blond." She relies on weaving (highlights) on the top for a glamorous shine



and a perm underneath for volume.

To do her current style (left) Donna starts with Clairol's Kindness to add body and blow dries it with a diffuser. Meanwhile, she scrunches with her fingers or uses clamps to crimp it. If extra curl is needed, she gets it by setting on electric rollers and finishes with hairspray.

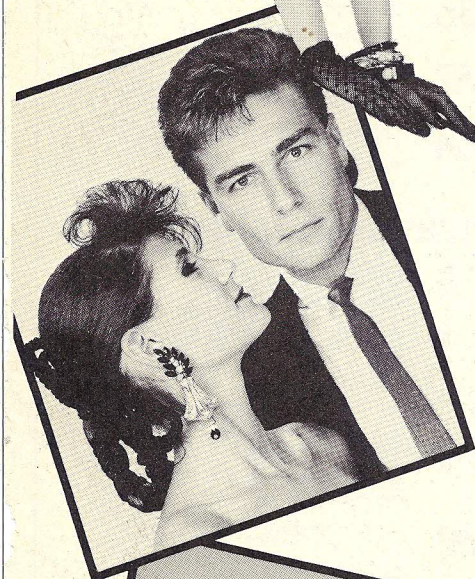
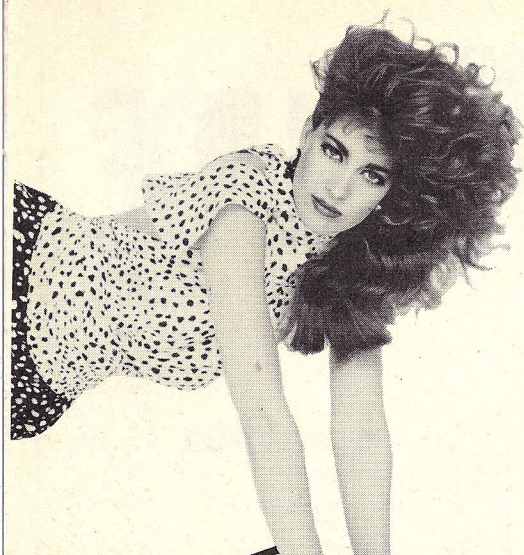
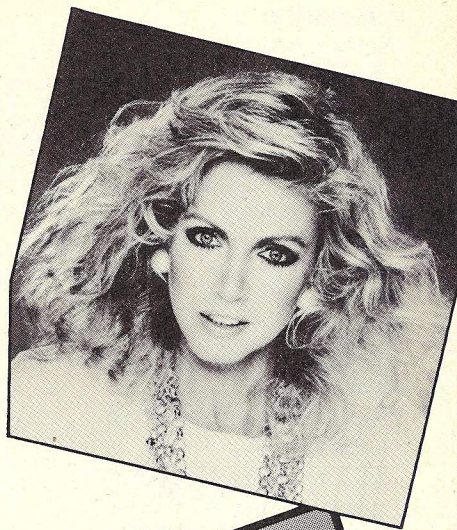
